## Some Family Ideas for Thanksgiving and Advent

## Thanksgiving:

- 1. Gratitude Jar- from now till end of month (Use Microphone and Parents)
- 2. Write a Family Prayer for Thanksgiving Dinner/or each prepare something
- 3. Make Food- Cookies- Deliver to 5-6 Neighbors w/card from kids about Thanksgiving/God/Gratitude (the one's you don't know too!) (Watch what happens)
  - Use to take about generosity
  - Ask kids- depending on age- they may answer different places (Deeper for older...)
- 4. Invite Someone who has no one for Thanksgiving- if you host

## Advent/Christmas

- 1. Go to the Christmas Parade with the Parish on Saturday, December 7th!
- 2. Get Advent Calendar (w/out Santa)- with chocolates
- 3. Redirect to Jesus- when focus turns to Santa-- ... but who is even more important than Santa...
- 4. Replace Elf on the Shelf with the Wisemen journeying to the Manger (different places/have fun!)
- 5. Build a Nativity Together (even take my course/lol)
  - Incorporate things from your life
  - Symbols from vacation materials, etc...
  - Things from Life (dog/skateboards/skis/football/etc... their interests too)
  - Encourage kids to be creative
  - If Jesus came today- where would he live....
  - Do it Every year or add- make it special family project (in mind all year)
- 6. Christmas Straw- Every year from Church to your creche

- 9. Turn focus from what they want--- to gratitude for what they have (think about holidays and the difference)

- 14. The Baby Jesus Hunt- Have Creches for each member of the Family
  - Before leaving for Mass- hide all the baby Jesus'
  - Kids have to find one (thus have set for each...)
  - Then when all found- sing away in the manager- as you process to each nativity
  - Bless nativity with family prayer
- 15. Say the St. Andrew Novena Daily from November 30- Christmas (see handout)
- 16. Visit the Holy Trinity, St. Martin, and St. Mary's to see their nativities
- 17. Watch Catholic Christmas Movies as a Family
  - a. Charlie Brown Christmas— watch for Linus' blanket drop in pageant-
  - b. The Nativity Story
  - c. The Fourth Wiseman
  - d. It's a Wonderful Life
  - e. Miracle on 34th Street
  - f. Christmas Carol (Muppets!)
  - g. Miracle of Marcelino
- 18. Take a Family Pilgrimage (Research what Catholic Church to Go To)
- 19. Take the Act of Generosity a Day Challenge for Advent- Have fun with it!
